- "In addition to Article II.30.4, beneficiaries shall deposit an electronic copy of the published version or the final manuscript accepted for publication [...] published before or after the final report in an institutional or subject-based repository at the moment of publication.
- Beneficiaries are required to make their best efforts to ensure that this electronic copy becomes freely and electronically available to anyone through this repository:
 - immediately if the scientific publication is published "open access", i.e. if an electronic version is also available free of charge via the publisher, or
 - within [X1] months of publication“.

QUESTIONS

- Who owns the copyright of my work?
- Will I break copyright if I store my work in the repository?
- Who can be held liable?
- What should I do if my publisher doesn't allow me to deposit my work in a repository?
- Which funders have an open access policy?
- What version of the paper is under this policy?
- Will a "secondary publication right" change the landscape?
- Is PDF a solution for the digital age?

GRATIS <> LIBRE

- BMJ Open
 - "Authors will retain copyright. Publishing using a creative commons licence will impose no (non-commercial) restrictions on articles' use."
- Nature Scientific Reports
 - "Open access articles will be published under a Creative Commons licence. Authors may choose between the Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivs 3.0 Unported and the Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike 3.0 Unported licence."

GRATIS <> LIBRE

- SpringerOpen
 - "The SpringerOpen Copyright and License Agreement (identical to the Creative Commons Attribution License) formalizes these and other terms and conditions of publishing research articles."
- Wiley Open Access
 - "Authors retain copyright and articles are published under the Creative Commons Attribution Non Commercial License."

Final [#OpenAccess](#) rant: the power is in the hands of the authors. Ignore what publishers say: repositories and websites exist, use them
